25 to 27 September 2009

An instructive and diverting weekend to be held at Dimbola Lodge and Farringford at Freshwater. Shortly after his wedding in 1864 G F Watts took his new wife on holiday to the highly fashionable Isle of Wight where they stayed with the idiosyncratic pioneer photographer, Julia Margaret Cameron. This is the starting point for our journey of exploration into Ellen Terry and the microcosm nurtured by Julia at Dimbola Lodge.

The weekend will consist of a variety of talks, a guided tour, a film and an original theatrical performance focusing on both Ellen and Freshwater. Speakers include Katharine Cockin, Brian Hinton, Colin Ford and Veronica Franklin Gould. Topics to be covered by our expert speakers range from “*the Freshwater Circle*” to Photography as Art.

Proceedings begin on Friday evening at Dimbola Lodge, former home of Julia Margaret Cameron and now home to an extensive original collection of her photographs. On Saturday there will be an opportunity to have a guided tour of the collection and the day will be spent at Dimbola.

On Sunday the focus shifts to Farringford, Tennyson’s island retreat, now a privately run hotel featuring the newly restored Tennyson library. This is also the hotel where participants will be accommodated for the weekend. On Sunday afternoon there will be a professional performance of an original theatrical piece inspired by Ellen Terry’s visit to Freshwater in 1864.

## Booking Conditions

- The weekend is offered at a fully inclusive price per person . There are three types accommodation -
  - **STANDARD BEDROOM:** £286.00 pp single occupancy or £226.00 pp if sharing
  - **TENNYSON BEDROOM:** £336.00 single occupancy pp or £250.00 pp if sharing.
  - **ALFRED COTTAGES:** (2 bedrooms) £396.00 single occupancy of the cottage pp or £246.00 if sharing. Each bedroom is en suite and can accommodate two single or one double.
- The price covers:  
Two nights bed and breakfast at Farringford Hotel.  
Hot and cold style buffet on Friday and Saturday evening at Dimbola Lodge;  
Tea, coffee or juice and tray bake during breaks, lunch on Saturday at Dimbola,  
Sunday Lunch at Farringford.
- Use of meeting rooms and other facilities at the Hotel and at Dimbola Lodge, Admission to the Theatrical performance on Sunday afternoon.
  - The weekend begins at around 18.00 at Dimbola Lodge on Friday 25th September and ends around 17.00 on Sunday 27th September.
  - The details as given here may be subject to change. Between now and the start of the weekend, the organisers will continue to develop the programme to create the best possible event.
  - Accommodation will be provided at Farringford Hotel.
  - Booking must be made using one of these application forms. The full fees are payable at the time of booking.
